Many of you helped to make our Christmas celebrations special for the children and adults under our care. You blessed us with your gifts during 2018 so that we could continue to care for all of them. 2018 was a struggle for Rescue Cambodia as we had to manage underfunded. The Lord provided needed essentials but throughout the year our faith was stretched and some things had to be put on hold.

**As we go into 2019 may we appeal to you, Friends of Place of Rescue. Please help us as much as you can.**

Here are some ideas and projects for your consideration:

- Sponsor a child for \$50 a month. You will receive a photo and bio and updates twice a year.
- Provide \$2,500 per month for needed supplies such as soap, shampoo, tooth paste, noodles, fish sauce and condensed milk.
- Donate. 50 kilo sack of rice for \$30 U.S. Or better yet, enough rice for a household for \$330 a month.
- Donate any amount up to \$500 to repair playground equipment. Some more than 10 yrs. old
- Donate any amount for medicine for Grannies, adults coping with AIDS and children. Most of our Grannies have some kind of medical condition. We use an average of \$3,000 a month for medical care.
- Sponsor one of our school teachers for \$285 a month.
- Sponsor a university student for \$2,000 a year. This pays for all expenses including tuition.
- Donate for "as needed"
