Srey Keo is 5. Her mother died a couple of years ago of alcohol related health problems and her father died recently of the same kind of thing. After her father died, she lived in a little hovel with an elderly man in his late 80's. He was not her real grandfather but he had compassion on her. This week she became one of the little ones the Heavenly Father is caring for in His Kingdom at Place of Rescue 2 in Mongkol Borey.
