As individuals or as groups, they had engaged in smoking, drinking, inappropriate touching between boys and girls and general disobedience and contempt towards their House Moms. As a consequence they have had to leave the loving shelter of Place of Rescue and go stay with poor relatives who, while not their parents and unable to care for them permanently, consented to receive them for a period of 3 months during which time, it is hoped that the harvest of righteousness will result.
