

As I have traveled in recent months, meeting many people, I have been told over and over again, "I am praying for you and for Rescue." Thank you everyone who is interceding for us. We need your prayer and support so much as we move on into a busy fall.

Soon the students who studied in grade 12 will receive the results of their final examinations. We hope they will all have passed and will be able to leave for further education in Phnom Penh or in Svay Sisaphon. There is a huge problem though. Not only must they have passed their exams, they must also have funding for their university education. At the present time, Rescue Cambodia does not have sufficient funds to send them. In addition to the 35 who are presently in university, there are 22 students who will hopefully graduate this year. Sokthon Chhat and his board have made the difficult decision that if a new student is not sponsored, he/she will not be able to go. So I am appealing to you friends. A whole year



sponsorship for a student is only \$2,600 CND a year. This provides for all their expenses including tuition and living expenses as they stay in our dormitories. Of this amount \$600 is already provided by individual sponsorships, leaving a balance of \$2,000 CDN for the year. Are you able to help sponsor a Rescue Cambodia student? Perhaps you can find a few friends to join you in providing for the future of one of these worthy young people.
